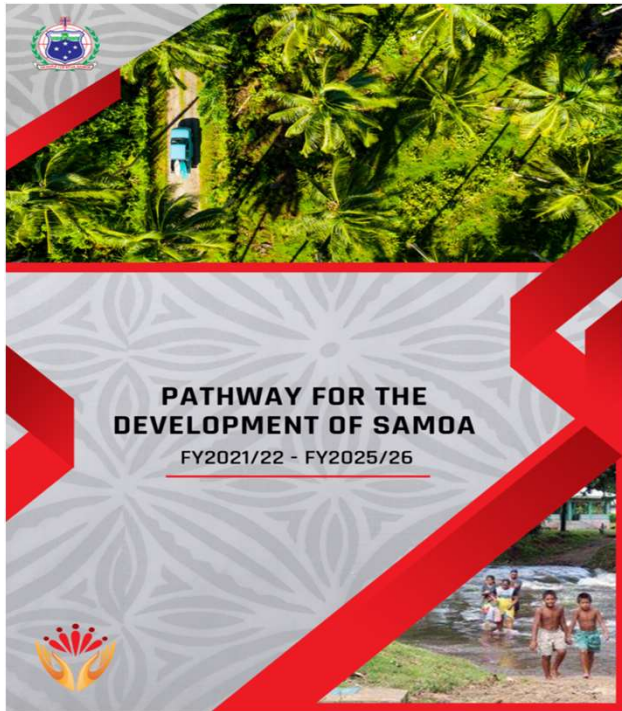

1. Mainstreamed the PSIP process. Best practices are incorporated into Samoa planning processes
2. Promoted awareness with all M&A's of Government (including prioritization)
3. Improved central role to coordinate and provide proactive advice to Government Ministries and Agencies to encourage new projects and better understanding of the process.
4. Better alignment of the PSIP with National Priorities through the establishment of a prioritization methodology – Multi Criteria Analysis.
